Hungarian Intellectual Property Office (HIPO)



After graduating from the Faculty of Chemical Engineering of Budapest University of Technology and Economics specialized to pharmaceutical chemistry, she stayed with the university for her Ph.D. studies. After having completed her studies and gotten the Ph.D. degree, she has been appointed researcher of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences for 3 years. During this period she spent 6 months at the Cambridge University (UK) with Professor Ian Fleming as a young visitor scientist doing research work in the field of organic silyl compounds.

In the year 2000 she joined the former Hungarian Patent Office (now Hungarian Intellectual Property Office) as a patent examiner in the Pharmaceutical Section. Her main duties were search and substantive examination of patent applications coming from the pharmaceutical sector, especially in the field of steroid hormones and quinoline derivatives.

In 2009 she became technical counsellor of the HIPO. From that time she regularly gives lectures on intellectual property to junior patent examiners and patent attorneys, respectively. Her main interest is focusing on the patentability issues of pharmaceutical inventions on which she published several papers in the official journal of the HIPO „Industrial Property and Copyright Review”.

In 2012 she became head of the Agricultural and Plant Variety Section (now Pharmaceutical and Agricultural Section), in 2015 became deputy head of the Patent Department. Since 2019 she has been head of the Patent Department.
